

The opening marks a significant shift for the neighborhood, as BLK Coffee will serve as the first-ever dedicated neighborhood café for the Amani community.

The café is scheduled for a soft opening on May 15, operating with limited morning hours from 6 a.m. to 11 a.m. Owners say this initial phase will allow them to connect with residents and refine their operations before hosting a full grand opening celebration later this summer.

The arrival of BLK Coffee is the first business to activate the Eban building, a transformative project designed to consolidate essential services under one roof. Once fully operational, the three-story hub is intended to function as a "one-stop-shop" for the community, integrating retail spaces, professional services, and onsite childcare.

"This is about more than just coffee," said a project spokesperson. "It's about bringing a gathering space into the heart of the community that offers both high-quality amenities and professional support systems."

The Eban building aims to serve as an anchor for local economic development, providing not only a place to grab a morning latte but also a venue that fosters neighborhood connectivity.

For those looking to get a first look at the new space, the May 15 soft opening will be the first opportunity to experience the café's atmosphere and menu. Residents are encouraged to visit early between 6 a.m. and 11 a.m. to beat the morning rush and welcome this new addition to the neighborhood.
